Frequently Asked Questions

When will I get the Contest Photo and what size is it?

When will the contest be up on display?

The whole month of July and August 2011.

Where will the money go that is collected from the voting?

All proceeds from the voting will go to the Alliance Kiwanis to be used for pediatric trauma care in Alliance.

Where does the portion of the session fee go and why?

A portion of each session is donated to the Alliance Kiwanis Club to be used for pediatric trauma care in Alliance.

What happens if my family and friends are out of the Alliance area, can they still vote?

You can mail them a ballot that you can pick up at Dairy Queen in Alliance or Stephs Studio
Or they can go online at www.stepsstudio.com and click on Vote Now! Print out the ballot and mail it to Stephs Studio ~PO Box 964~ Alliance, NE 69301

How else can the images be viewed for the contest?

By going to www.stepsstudio.com and clicking on Vote Now! You will be able to view the images and select an image number to vote for.

When and where will the winners be announced?

After the results are tabulated you will receive a call if your child is one of the award winners.
Ribbons will also be placed on the displays. Also, the winners will be announced online by clicking on view winners.
